1. New Routes

- KLM Royal Dutch Airlines have returned to London City Airport last month after an absence of almost eight years. The Dutch airline have initially commenced a daily service to Amsterdam from London City which is set to increase to four daily flights on weekdays and one to two flights a day during the weekends.
- British Airways will be launching a three time a week service to the Greek Island of Skiathos in the Summer, alongside the current routes of Mykonos and Santorini.
- British Airways has also announced the launch of a weekly service between LCY and Manchester, starting in May.

2. LCY Voted The Easiest Airport To Get To

In The Independent's annual survey London City Airport jumped to first place in it's annual survey of transport links to the UK's leading airports. The survey rates airports on the off-peak frequency, journey time and cost of the main link to the city they serve. The number of DLR trains between London City airport and Canning Town doubled in February this year, providing passengers with even better access to the City. There is now one DLR train every five minutes.

3. Brick Lane Brews, Now Open in Departures

Brick Lane Brew has now opened in the departures pier by Gate 2b. Run by local East End brewery Trumans, Brick Lane Brews serves locally produced beer, coffee and biegels.
